- 1. Will reimbursement for college tuition change?**
Collective bargaining agreements and MMC Affiliate Services employment policies are expected to remain in place at close.
- 2. Will we receive a salary increase depending on how well we do on our yearly performance evaluation?**
MMC Affiliate Services will determine the policies around salary increases for its employees.
- 3. Will sick day/personal day/vacation accrual policy change? Will time earned be carried over?**
For those who are employed by MMC Affiliate Services after close, sick day/personal day/vacation days will remain in place. For those moving to the physicians' professional corporation, sick day/personal day/vacation days will roll over.
- 4. Will Maimonides remain an 1199 hospital?**
Yes, based on conversations with 1199 representatives, we fully expect that current union relationships will remain in place.
- 5. What are the names/titles of the Physicians' group?**
NYC Physician Practice PC.
- 6. What do we do now if a patient presents a NYC Care card?**
For now, continue to do what you have done previously. When Maimonides is able to serve NYC Care patients, we will provide guidance and implementation support.
- 7. After April 1, will providers have to be re-credentialed with insurance carriers and receive new tax ID #s?**
After close, providers will join the recredentialing cycle NYC Health + Hospitals uses for all the providers credentialed at its hospitals. The recredentialing with payors will occur as other work for consolidation of billing functions progresses in preparation for Epic.
- 8. With the transaction, how will malpractice insurance be handled? Will current cases be handled by new lawyers?**
We expect that in general, current cases will continue to be handled by current attorneys. Guidance on any future cases will be forthcoming.
- 9. Post-transaction, will Maimonides keep its 501c3 status? This will affect people in the public service loan forgiveness program. Will MMC Affiliate Services continue to be a 501c3?**
Yes, MMC Affiliate Services will be a 501c3.
- 10. Will the Vanderbilt MMC Specialty Care site close?**
We are not planning to close any sites at this time.
